5	Procedure for inviting Application for the award	While reviewing the nominations of National Awards for the prevention of pollution the selection committee identifies the best among these particularly from the angle of adoption of clean technology for the Rajiv Gandhi Award.
6	Eligibility Criteria	The units which make a significant and measurable contribution towards the development of new or innovative modification of existing or remarkable or adoption and use of clean technologies and practices that substantially reduce eliminate or prevent environmental pollution. The activities can include new technologies that save energy, other resources, produce reformulation or substitution to use fewer polluting materials and modified or new process, which reduce pollution. The Significance of the contribution both in qualitative as well as measurable impact on the environment will be among the major criteria for selection .
