**REGISTRATION WITH THE COMMITTEE BY
PERSON (S) / ESTABLISHMENT (S) CARRYING ON THE BUSINESS OF THE
BREEDING OF ANIMALS OR TRADE OF ANIMALS FOR THE PURPOSE OF
EXPERIMENTS**

The Committee for the Purpose of Control and Supervision of Experiments on Animals (CPCSEA), under the Ministry of Environment and Forests, is statutory body, constituted under Section 15 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 [hereinafter referred to as Act], for the purpose of controlling and supervising experiments on animals.

The Breeding of and Experiments on Animals (Control and Supervision) Rules 1998 [hereinafter referred to as Rules] have been framed under Section 17 of the above Act.

Rule 3 & 4 inter-alia, requires person (s) / establishment (s), to register with the CPCSEA for carrying on the business of the breeding of animals or trade of animals for the purpose of experiments.

Take Notice that if any person/ establishment is found carrying on any business of breeding of animals or trade of animals, for the purpose of experiments without registration with the CPCSEA, such person (s) / establishment (s) shall attract penal action under Section 20 of the above Act.
