

**Draft Addendum Report for Environmental & Social Impacts and Mitigation  
Measures for In-situ Remediation options for Hooghly HW sites, West Bengal and  
Noor Mohammad Kunta, HW site, Andhra Pradesh under the World Bank aided  
Capacity Building for Industrial Pollution Management Project  
For Comments**

1. The Ministry of Environment and Forests is implementing Capacity Building for Industrial Pollution Management Project with the objective to support the development of institutional and methodological framework for implementing of pilots for rehabilitation of highly polluted sites resulting from rapid industrialization.
2. Ministry of Environment and Forests, under this Project has engaged International Consultants Technocrats Private Ltd. (ICT) to carry out the Environmental & Social Assessment (ESA) study so as to strengthen the relevant solid and Hazardous Waste Management policies, regulations and institutional framework. The objective of the ESA study includes the following:
  - (i) Conduct an ESA that assists MoEF in strengthening the relevant policy, regulatory and institutional framework.
  - (ii) Develop a safeguard framework for the area based sub-project and other investments based on applicable policies, regulations, norms and standards related to the implementation of area based approaches.
  - (iii) Develop guidelines for environmentally assessing the types of sub-projects likely to be implemented in the various states as part of this project and for developing an EMP.
  - (iv) On the basis of (ii) and (iii) prepare a framework for consultation whereby concerned stakeholders become part of the ESA and can be appropriately included in implementation plans and keep a detailed written record of all consultations.
  - (v) Conduct rapid assessment screening as part of due diligence procedures for all sub project sites in each State. Results of screening should establish a description of the area relevant to the polluted sites subject to project interventions-in line with the area based approach that includes the basic parameters related to the environmental, socio-economic and any legal/political aspects of the site. The screening also should ensure that environmental and social safeguards are properly implemented for each site.
3. A copy of the draft report can be downloaded from the website. It will be displayed on the website for 45 days for inviting comments of policy makers/Industries & Industries Association / Individuals / experts / academicians etc. All are requested to forward their valuable comments within 45 days so that the same are considered by the Ministry for finalizing the report.
